Hereinafter called the "Obligor", is held and firmly bound to the Highway Authority of the Township of Naperville, Illinois, a body politic and corporate, hereinafter called the "Obligee" in the sum of

That the above obligation is to guarantee good and faithful performance concerning the construction of access, the paving of appropriate right-of-way and/or culvert(s) of appropriate size upon the premises described as:

Now the Conditions:

1. The Obligor shall construct the said access drive and/or culvert in full compliance with the Ordinances of the County of DuPage, Illinois, and specifically, but not limited to, Ordinance # 8-112.6.
2. The Obligor upon receipt of an ENTRANCE PERMIT, as prepared by the Highway Authority of the Township, said permit shall specify the requirements and/or instructions and said requirements and/or requirements shall be a condition of this bond, and shall adhere to the requirements within the ENTRANCE PERMIT.
3. And to secure performance of the aforesaid conditions, the undersigned obligor does hereby, irrevocably authorize any attorney of any Court of record to appear for the Obligor, in any such Court in term time or vacation, at any time hereafter and confess judgement without process against the Obligor in favor of the obligee for the said amount deposited and to waive and release all errors which may intervene in any such proceeding, and to consent to immediate execution upon judgment, and that any execution that may be issued on any such judgment may be immediately levied upon and satisfied out of the aforesaid sum deposited with the office of Highway authority; hereby ratifying and confirming all that said attorney may do by virtue hereof.
4. Final inspection of said access drive and/or culvert is to be made by the Highway Authority or his duly authorized agent.
5. In the event that the said access drive and/or culvert, upon final inspection by the aforesaid Highway Authority, or his duly authorized agent, does not conform fully with the aforementioned Ordinance and/or requirements and/or instructions as detailed in the ENTRANCE PERMIT, then, the above sum shall be forfeited to the Obligee.
6. That the Obligor shall within two (2) years from the date of issuance of building permit by the County make written application for a release and refund of said surety. That said refund application shall include a copy of the County Occupancy Permit. FAILURE TO APPLY FOR A REFUND WITHIN TWO (2) YEARS SHALL RESULT IN A FORFEITURE OF SAID BOND.
7. If the Obligor shall in all things, well and truly perform all of the aforesaid terms and conditions of the construction of said drive and/or culvert, then the sum of \$ _____ less administrative fee (\$50.00) and damage fees shall be returned to the Obligor.

Special Instructions Entrance Bonds and Permits

SIDEWALK SPECIFICATIONS

- Shall be 4" compacted stone base. Squares shall be 4' wide, 4" thick; 6" thick if through the driveway (per County Code) 6-bag mix.
- **Call** this office (630-978-0380) 24 hours in advance for prepour inspection of gravel and forms in place. Failure to call will extend bond release time and/or forfeiture of bond.

DRIVE APRON SPECIFICATIONS

- Shall be 6" minimum compacted stone and minimum 2" asphalt or 6" concrete.
- **Call** this office (630-978-0380) for prepave/pour inspection. Failure to call will extend bond release time and/or forfeiture of bond.

Call for final inspection of sidewalk or drive after all black dirt is delivered and rough landscape complete. Follow with a written request that job is complete and that bond money be released. Inspection will follow within one week, with bond money to follow if work is found to be satisfactory.

OTHER IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

No track machines on roadway.

All utility connections across pavement by auguring , and utility contractors to post separate bond with this office.

No decorative boulders, timbers, above-grade head walls or brick pillars are permitted in right-of-way.

Tree planting in right of way requires a permit from this office.

Under **NO** circumstance can a contractor use Township Road or right of way for stock-piling any kind of materials.
